      - Suicide Prevention program implemented is *Signs of Suicide* which includes a depression screening for students to take and counselors to review. Program is implemented in numerous settings throughout the districts.
      - Violence Prevention efforts include *Boys’ and Girls’ Empowerment groups, Safe Dates, and Love: All That & More*. Programs are implemented in numerous setting throughout the districts; however, *SD* and *LATM* are mostly implemented in health classes.
