Working on adapting curriculum with online and virtual prevention programming (in partnership with Robin at Turning Point) - successful virtual programming at Buckeye Valley and Hayes High Schools. Can implement a virtual presentation (e.g. could use polls), follow up presentations, and/or pre recorded videos and worksheets. Thank you for LOS for FVPSA application. RPE continuation funding for SV prevention work (including community level work - policy and messaging). **Suicide Prevention** - been able to get into schools. marketing QPR and looking for other ways to get information out to community (e.g. pizza box flyers)

**NAMI** - ending the silence program (MS/HS recognize warning signs of MH and how to help friend/self). One for students, one for family, one for staff. Only offered student so far. Have now trained folks to do the family and staff training. Gotten into Big Walnut and Buckeye Valley with presentations. Talking with schools about virtual offerings.

**Syntero**- Winter wellness workshops for students. Backing our Front Line program funded by DMMHRB - 3-6 short term sessions - person linked to masters level MH prof to support with covid pandemic stressors. can link to additional services. covered by grant funding. for traditional first responders, health care, and those that work in any capacity in the schools (Del/Mor Cos). Next day support, coping skills and support.
