- **Welcome and Introductions:** PEACE Coordinator, Amy Hawthorne opened the meeting - members signed in.
 - **Meeting Minutes** – February 21, 2019 meeting minutes were reviewed – Jamica Harper made a motion to approve and Katherine Hostiuck seconded. February minutes were approved.
 - **Updates from Amy** – NA
- **General Meeting:**
1. Day of Silence – April 12, 2019 HL supported and assisted in implementing DOS with two Delaware high schools. Hayes High Schools and Olentangy Orange High School carried out successful DOD events. Amy shared the different site activities and reported no major incidents. DOS activities, including the mayoral proclamation spurred conversation by students, teachers, and advisors about bringing a Pride Parade to Delaware County. Amy has only begun to have conversations about convening a group to explore this opportunity. If you're interested in being a part of those conversations, please let Amy Hawthorne know ASAP.
 2. PEACE Prevention Calendar – Kristen Beal continues to reach out and request events for the calendar. Please contact her at kbeal@helplinedelmor.org to include your events on the website/calendar. From the conversation, it was determined that a reminder email is needed; therefore, Kristen will reach out the last week of every month for updates. Julie discussed an online portal that is being utilized by the SAFE Delaware County Coalition and how PEACE may benefit from something similar. Further research and information will be evaluated to determine if a similar portal is possible.
 3. Delaware City Prevention Educator Training — A training development committee is in the process of being formed. This committee will be responsible for creating the agenda, determining training date/s, bringing experts to the table, finding/creating presentations, and applying for training professional development hours – if you would like to join the TDC please contact Amy Hawthorne ahawthorne@helplinedelmor.org. TDC meetings will convene in May.
 4. PEACE Collaborative Annual Prevention Matrix – Amy Hawthorne will reach out to Prevention Providers to compile their academic school year reach. The data does not need to be specific or detailed; we are looking to provide a snapshot view to partner agencies, school districts, and other stakeholders. Amy will send an email to providers during the first week of May – providers need to get their information to the PEACE Collaborative during the first week of June in preparation for our June 19 meeting.
 5. YRBS Update – Kelsey Kuhlman provided a detailed YRBS implementation update to the group. The 2019-2020 YRBS will be administered to students in September 2019 by all districts. The final survey is almost complete and will have around 82-86 questions on both MS and HS surveys. The comprehensive implementation will provide greater than statistically significant results.
