- **General Meeting:**
 - Sub-Committee Updates - PASC
 - Kelsey Kuhlman – Will present to multiple Delaware County school boards about YRBS and discuss prevention efforts at each district.
 - Youth Advisory Board (YAB) – recruitment efforts are ongoing. Posters and applications have been taken to every Delaware County high school. The online application portal has been shared with multiple administrative and teacher contacts at all high schools. Julie Krupp will speak with HS SRO's to identify students that would be a good fit and encourage them to apply. Amy Hill suggests adding something grant related to each agenda of the YAB meetings in addition to their projects, getting input from youth for multiple initiatives will strengthen their participation and serve community.
 - Sub-Committee Updates – ISC
 - Infrastructure Subcommittee will work on strategic plan draft. Draft will be ready for review and approval by PEACE Collaborative members in Jan. 2018. Amy Hawthorne will work on initial draft to present to ISC for review, ideas, and edits.
 - Peace Website will be updated with county prevention reach information. Information will be conveyed in non-duplicative manner to highlight number of students served; will utilize word clouds and word bubbles of prevention services if possible. Amy Hawthorne will communicate with Erin Coss to update PEACE website accordingly.
