 1. TGIF Train the Trainers – Amy updated the group on December TGIF Train the Trainers, schools represented, and successful feedback from participants.
 2. Mid-School Year Update – Prevention educator’s present at meeting offered information on where their programmatic numbers were at winter break.
 3. Prevention Funding Grant Applications – Amy updated group on which funding applications (specific to HelpLine) were out and when they were expecting to hear back.

- Ben McDay – MaryHaven expansion in Morrow County to include MH staff and law enforcement officers together to respond to overdoses, helping people to seek treatment immediately rather than prosecution.
- Mike Brockfield – Big Brothers Big Sisters has increased enrollment in all programs, more volunteers and adult mentors are needed. Mentors needed specifically for non-school based programming. BBBS has also helped 18 families this holiday season.
- Sejal Parikh – Buckeye Valley East Elementary construction is moving along – staff will move after Presidents Day in February.
