○ **General Meeting:**

1. **Prevention Funding** – Amy informed the collaborative of Helpline’s ODH RPE funding and discussed project initiatives and goals. Funding will focus on outer (community/societal) levels of the public health model/CDC’s spectrum of prevention. ODH RPE funding will begin Feb. 1, 2020. Additionally, HL has received funding from the Women’s Fund of Central Ohio for the TGIF Leadership Cohort. The cohort will be a skills building leadership group for high school girls to develop, cultivate, and implement skills to lead and inspire. We will send application links & QR coded flyers to our high schools in early January. Cohort will begin to meet in February or March. Modules for monthly cohort meetings are: 1. Negotiation, Assertive Communication & Public Speaking, 2. Economic Empowerment & Financial Literacy, 3. Defining Leadership Style & Goal Setting, 4. Identify, Challenge, & Manage Barrier’s to Women’s Participation in Leadership Roles, 5. Stress Management, Wellness, & Self-Care, 6. Student Leadership Involvement, 7. Evaluation & Data Analysis, 8. Advocacy, Self-Advocacy, & Allyship. Additionally, the cohort will work throughout the year on their capstone project, the 2020 Girls Supporting Girls Conference.
