- **Welcome and Introductions:** PEACE Coordinator, Amy Hawthorne opened the meeting - members signed in.
 - **Meeting Minutes** – December 19, 2018 meeting minutes were electronically disseminated.
 - **Updates from Amy** – NA
- **General Meeting:**
1. YAB – The Youth Advisory Board will not formally meet this school year. With staff turnover requiring more classroom time there are less and less resources available for the facilitation and coordination for a YAB and maintain the communication/schedule/meeting implementation. Amy will work over the summer to coordinate a YAB committee for assistance and responsibility sharing.
 2. Day of Silence – This year’s DOS will be held on Friday, April 12th. Two high schools, Delaware Hayes HS and Olentangy Orange HS will be utilizing support from HL in their implementation and messaging. Activities include “Breaking the Silence” parties at both sites. Additionally, youth will join Amy Hawthorne during the April Delaware City – City Council Meeting to speak about DOS during the mayoral proclamation recognition.

 4. PEACE Collaborative Evaluation Implementation and Evaluation of PEACE Coordinator – As part of our PEACE strategic plan we indicate an annual evaluation. The group will need to think of relevant questions for the survey/evaluation. As part of the discussion - members indicated a Likert Scale would be best to gather information in a google form. Members discussed potential prevention questions for survey as well topic areas to focus on. The discussion continues as no progress has been made in this area.
 5. Delaware City Prevention Educator Training – PEACE Members discussed multiple ideas regarding the first Prevention Educator Training. Ideas include: 1. Contacting prevention experts to maintain validity while addressing educators needs for readiness. 2. Conducting and disseminating a brief survey to collect information about what topics training should address. 3. Apply to OCDB with training so educators can get professional development hours for attending. 4. Partner with Public Speaking expert to improve storytelling in educators. 5. Work with Connections to advertise and organize training. 6. Consult teachers for their insight and include in Professional Development days. – A training development committee will be formed – if you would like to join the TDC please contact Amy Hawthorne ahawthorne@helplinedelmor.org
