- **Welcome and Introductions:** PEACE Coordinator, Amy Hawthorne opened the meeting - members signed in.
- August meeting minutes were reviewed – minutes approved by Kelsey Kuhlman
- **General Meeting:**
  1. Prevention Matrix – how often should the matrix be updated? A discussion to determine how often prevention providers should update matrix and how to best express/show prevention reach to community partners who utilize information. It was determined that updates should occur once a year at the end of the school year unless otherwise necessary. Prevention information will be provided to Amy Hawthorne in June and compiled/shared in July.
  2. YRBS information will be combined with adult health survey information to provide a more comprehensive community snapshot. As information becomes available and is announced PEACE Collaborative will then identify appropriate action steps.
  3. TGIF Train the Trainers event will take place on Dec. 7-8. Training is invitation only for school and community partners working with youth and interested in incorporating TGIF programming at their sites.
